

## **Covid Safety Measures for St Nicholas' Parish Church**

We have taken great care to ensure that you can join us as safely as possible at the Eucharist and other services in the week. Government guidance is constantly evolving, so things may change from one week to the next – please read our weekly email to stay informed.

### **Covid-secure worship in the Parish Church during the National Lockdown**

- Our current capacity is 30.
- Please arrive in good time for mass: doors open 15 minutes before a service begins.
- Please use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit
- Wear a face covering over your nose and mouth all the time you are in the building.  
This is now mandatory, except for those with medical exemptions.
- The stewards will direct you to a seat; please remain there until they direct you to the nearest exit at the end of the service.
- Communion, in one kind only, will be brought to your seat. The hosts will be in a covered container, and the clergy will sanitise their hands before distribution.
- An NHS Test & Trace form and pen are on each chair. If you are happy to leave your details, please fill in the form and place it in the Test and Trace tin as you leave. Test & trace information is retained for this purpose only, and disposed of securely after 21 days. If you prefer to use a QR code, this is displayed in the porch and by the sanitiser table.
- Make every effort to maintain 2m physical distance from one another. Mingling in the church and churchyard is not permitted.

Please stay at home if you are feeling unwell, or if you or any member of your household have symptoms of coronavirus
